## *Sight Word Color-Wheels and Shapes*

The color wheels and shapes on the following pages are designed to provide opportunities for the children to demonstrate their level of mastery of the spelling and sight words, while also reinforcing their knowledge of the basic shapes and colors. There are two exercises on each of these eighteen pages with a total of twelve words per page. After the children have studied these words and gained exposure and practice with identifying them, make copies of these pages and use them to do spelling tests. Be sure to have the children study and master the words printed on each page before administering the test.

The words printed on the color wheels and the sequence of word-to-color matches will allow the children to produce a color wheel with the colors in the order that they appear on an actual color-wheel with the six primary and secondary colors.

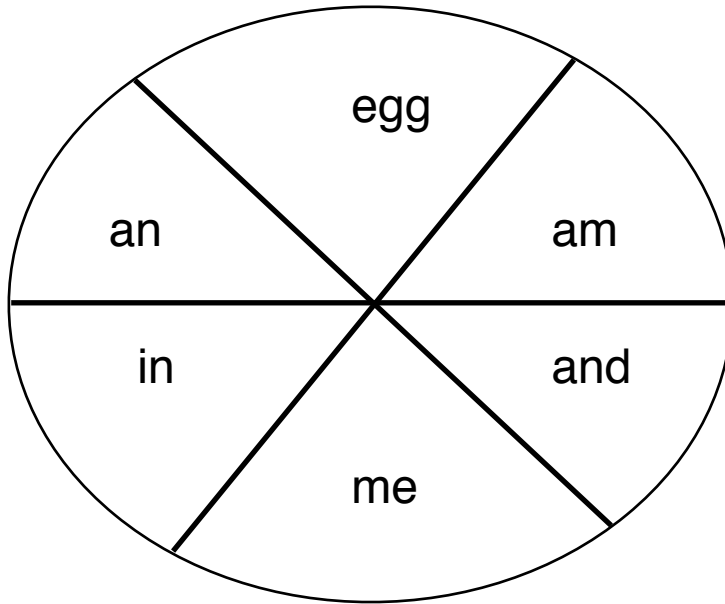
The primary colors are: red, yellow and blue. The secondary colors are: orange, green and violet (purple). The order in which these colors appear on a color wheel is: red, violet, blue, green, yellow and orange.

Besides gaining practice in spelling and writing each word, the children will gain the knowledge of the correct placement of each color on a color-wheel, by repeatedly coloring in the spaces on the wheel in their correct order, as they identify the words that you call out to them.

**Color Wheel #1**

Color the word **an** with **red**; color the word **egg** with **violet**; color the word **am** with **blue**; color the word **and** with **green**; color the word **me** with **yellow**; color the word **in** with **orange**.

**Color Wheel #2**

Color the word **of** with **red**; color the word **off** with **violet**; color the word **on** with **blue**; color the word **as** with **green**; color the word **is** with **yellow**; color the word **do** with **orange**.
