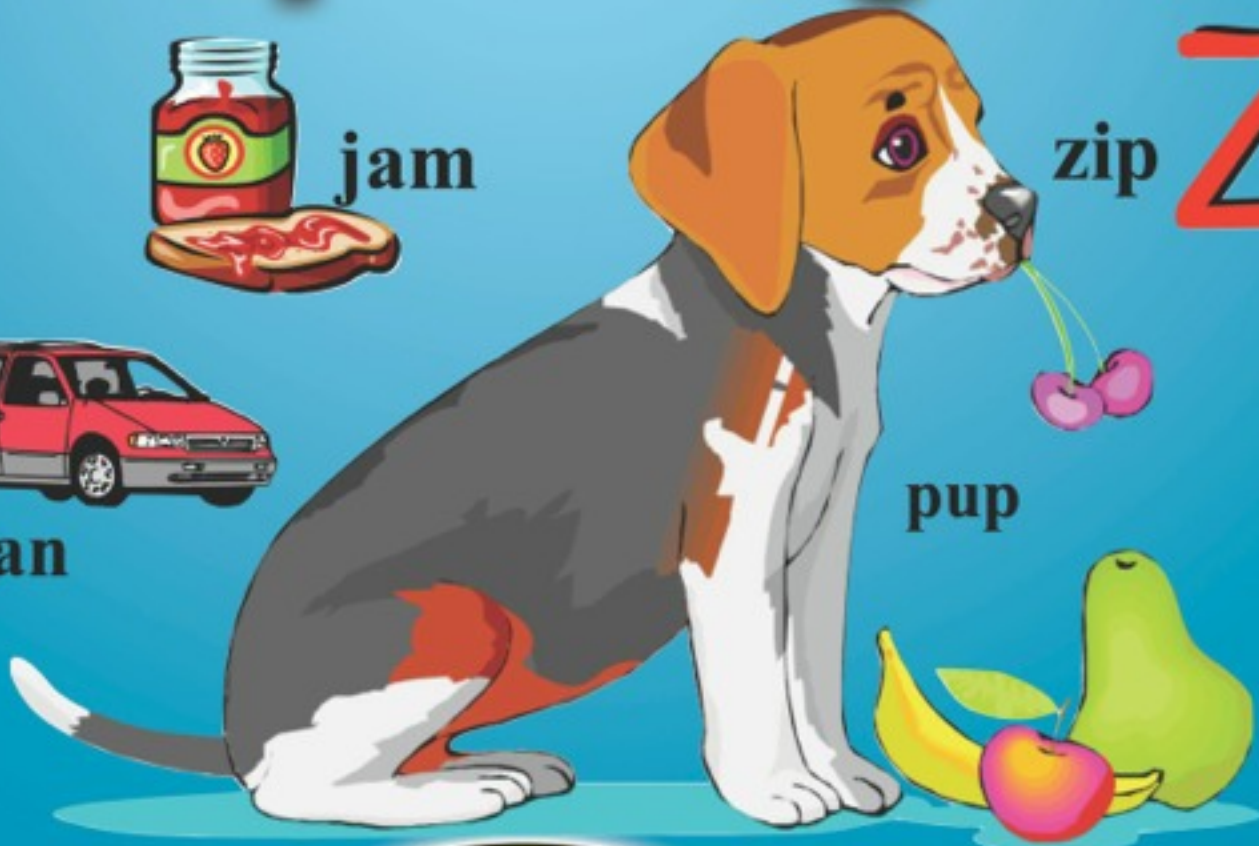

Preschool 4 Early Birdie Reader

The Emerge Early Birdie Reader provides the opportunity for the students to use what they learn from the Reading and Writing Skills curriculum to begin reading almost immediately. There are 140 spelling words in reading levels 1-3. All three levels are contained in the Early Birdie Reader. These words are used in simple sentences the preschool student begins reading almost immediately. The first 12 weeks of school are devoted to teaching or reviewing the alphabet and the sound each letter makes. These lessons are contained in the Preschool 4 Reading and Writing workbook. The teacher will teach one, two and the simplest three-letter words during the first twelve weeks of school, along with the alphabet. The students will begin reading from the readers during the 15th week of school. Student confidence will soar as they begin to read from the pages of their very own reader. Following are just a few of the words the students will learn to spell and read each week:

Week 7: a, an, egg, am

Week 8: and, I, me, in

Week 9: of, off, on

Week 10: as, is, do

Week 11: at, it, to, up

Week 12 ax, ox, eye

Week 13: can, art, fun, the, ape

Week 14: boy, see, big, log

Week 15: cut, bee, fly, bus. Students will be able to read pages 4-7 after week 15.

Week 16: cap, cat, sit, has. Students will be able to read pages 4-8 after week 16.



A is for art.

I can do art. Art is fun. The boy can do art. Art is fun to the boy.



B is for bus.

I see a bus. I see a big bus. The bee is on the bus.
The bee is on the big bus.



C is for cow.

See the cow. The cow is a fat cow. See the cow eat.
See the fat cow eat.



R is for rip.

See the boy. The boy has a rip. The rip is big. The boy has a big rip. Do you see the rip? K4
